Samaritan Counseling Center of the Fox Valley, Coming Together to Prevent Teen Suicide: Connected Community Wellness Screen - \$6,000: Teen suicide prevention program that provides free emotional wellness check-ups to teens right at school. The program identifies teens with increased suicide risk, then connects their families with mental health professionals for a full evaluation.

Youth Go, S.E.E.D. Program 3.0 - \$4,000: Provides career exploration for girls in grades 8-12 by **Seeing**, **Exploring**, being **Educated**, and **Dreaming**. Participants will be exposed to a number of potential career paths by learning from the words and examples of successful women in our community. Additionally, assistance will be available to those in need to take the ACT, apply for college, or to provide supplies needed for successfully completing tests and/or applications.
