Girls from Appleton North, Little Chute, Kaukauna, and Menasha high schools met in person in March and April for a two-day leadership training, community education, and grantmaking program. Through facilitated discussion, the girls identified issues important to them and their peers, and where they felt they could have the greatest impact with \$10,000 in grant funding. After much discussion, they agreed to support programs that help low-income students have access to mental health support.
